### **Introduction**

This report will be written in three sections:

### **Goal**

The goal is the same regardless of the client or situation. The goal of the counselors is to offer the client the opportunity to realize he/she can become self-sufficient enough to modify behavior and/or cope with situations dealing with personal/social, secondary education, post-secondary education, health, and or career concerns through individual conferences or group conferences either with the school counselor and/or with other helping professionals.

### **Counselor Availability**

The counseling program depends a great deal upon counselor availability. The following denotes the schedules of the two counselors:

- Jr./Sr. High School approximately forty (40) hours
- Elementary School approximately forty (40) hours

Outside of School – The counselors remain available after school hours for consultations at school, home visits, phone contact, and other commitments.

Flex Time – The counselors will continue some non-traditional hours, by appointment, to assist with accessibility.

### **Counselor Updates**

Both counselors continue to attend seminars and community meetings so as to keep current with progressive counseling trends.

### **Public Relations**
