

Junior High student council is sponsoring a Halloween dance on October 18,2019 in the west Burlington cafeteria. Students may enter from the high school entrance. The dance will start at 7 PM and end at 9PM. All junior high students are invited.

Students may wear Halloween costumes to the dance. Costumes are not allowed during the school day. All students need to follow the dress code school policies. No fake blood is allowed. No full masks or weapons or look alike weapons are allowed.

The junior high will have a parent to D.J (Zach Anderson). There will be a costume judging contest for best, cutest and scariest costume. Refreshments will be served. Chips and cookies will be available for 75 cents and water will cost 1 dollar.

School sponsored dances are held for the enjoyment of West Burlington Junior High students. All guests must be currently enrolled in West Burlington Junior High school. Students who leave a dance are not allowed to re-enter the dance. School district policies, rules and regulations apply to students as well as guests at school dances. Student and guests violating school district policies, rules or regulations will be asked to leave the dance and school grounds. To attend the dance students must have taken care of all financial and school obligations (including detentions and good conduct violations)..

General Guidelines

1. Lighting during dances will be maintained at a level determined by the school administration.
2. Only age appropriate music will not be allowed at dances. School administration will have final determination of what is deemed appropriate.
3. Only junior high students can attend junior high dances
4. All dances will end at 9:00pm. (Please have rides available to those students needing to be picked up after the dance.)
5. Students will not be allowed re-entry once they have left the dance.
6. All student code of conduct rules apply with an exception to school dress code.

Dance Guidelines

1. Only appropriate dancing will be allowed.
4. All dancers must remain on the ground, no lifting or carrying of dancers will be permitted.

Dress Guidelines

1. Dance clothing attire should be an appropriate length.
2. Clothing should not show undergarments.
3. Clothing should not expose the navel or below the navel.
4. Clothing attire should considered school appropriate.

School administration has final authority on what is determined acceptable dance attire. Failure to follow these guidelines could result in being asked to leave the event without a refund.
