Believe it or not, but basketball season is fast approaching. The purpose of this letter is to invite as many West Burlington boys in the 3rd-6th grades to begin, or continue, to develop their basketball skills by participating in upcoming youth basketball leagues. The first opportunity is by participating in the YMCA Youth Basketball League.

YMCA League

- Register at the Burlington Area YMCA (or online at burlingtony.org)
- Deadline for registration is Sunday, October 6th
- Cost is \$30 per person if Y member, \$50 for non-members
- If register after October 7th, \$10 late fee is assessed
- Games on Saturday's from November 9th – December 21st (No Games Thanksgiving Weekend)
- Participants receive team t-shirt
- Offers competition against players in same grade level

Teams will practice weekly during the YMCA league with playing time to be as equal as possible. The primary focus is to learn/develop individual fundamentals and team play.

Following the YMCA league (after the New Year) additional opportunities for play will be available for those who are interested in a more "competitive" environment as well. Last year, we were able to have 4th-6th grade boys continue to compete in a league involving other SEISC schools, as well as other area tournaments. The West Burlington Athletic Booster Club and West Burlington High School Boys Basketball program were generous enough to provide that opportunity at no-charge to our youth. The plan is to provide that same opportunity again this year, provided that there is enough interest.
